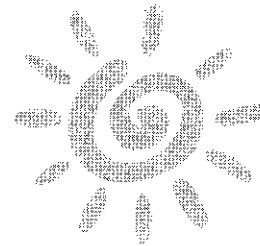

General Information for Sessions 1 & 2:

NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE 4:00 PM ON April 11th. Please note that **EACH** student must have **2** completed forms, a general registration form and a course registration form. Choose classes and use the registration form based upon the grade level students are **entering**. Extra forms are available at either school office. Please make checks payable to the Hustisford School District.

All fees are due with registration. See registration forms for any additional course materials fee. **Registration is not official until payment is received.** Please register during Early Bird registration to ensure placement in your desired class. A minimum of 12 students is needed to form a class. Registrations will be processed on a first come, first serve basis.

April 11 - On Site Early Bird Registration: Early Bird Registration fee is \$5.00 per resident student and \$25.00 per non-resident student plus any additional course materials fee (if applicable). Early Bird registration will take place in the JHE gym from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.

April 12 - April 18: Early Bird Fees apply: Drop forms off at either school during regular school hours or mail to Hustisford School District, PO Box 386, Hustisford, WI 53034, in care of Summer School. To receive the Early Bird discount, registration forms and payment must be received by April 18th.

Courses for all students, grades 4K through 12th grade, are listed in alphabetical order. Choose courses according to the grade your student will be entering in the Fall of 2018. Teacher recommendation is required for courses marked (R) Remedial. Classes will meet at the Junior/Senior High School or John Hustis Elementary School, with the exception of fishing and kayaking.

Students will learn about driving knowledge and laws and also attitudes, emotions, drugs and alcohol, insurance, and more. We will have a variety of guest speakers from the insurance industry, law enforcement, trucking industry, organ donation agency, and the Dodge County Highway Department. Upon successful completion of this classroom program, and age 15-1/2, students will be able to go to the DMV to take their test for their Temporary License (Temps) and to sign up for behind the wheel training.
