2017 BUILDING REFERENDUM | THE SOLUTION

Although needs exist at both John Hustis Elementary and the Jr/Sr High School, the School Board remains determined that the most immediate needs exist at John Hustis Elementary. The District looks for a solution to address all of the elementary needs that will provide learning environments to support the way teachers teach and students learn. The school board is confident that the solution being proposed will bring the elementary school up to today's standard/codes and extend the life of the building by 20+ years. Addressing these needs now will allow for future facility plans to focus solely on the needs at the Jr/Sr High School.

PROJECT ANALYSIS

1. Improvements of Safety & Security
Relocate office next to the front entry to provide secure entry and control of visitor access

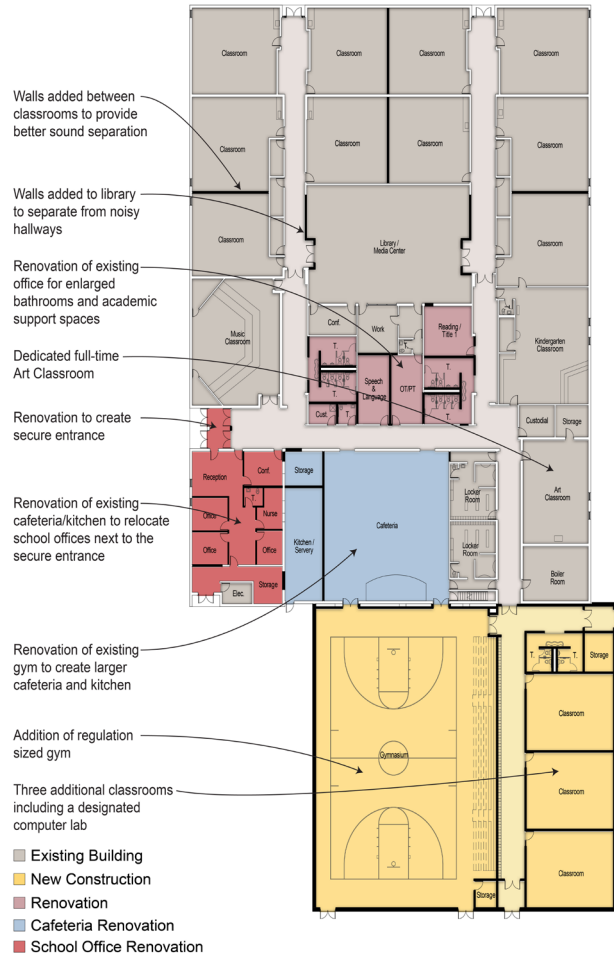


2. Cafeteria Inadequate - not enough seating which limits school scheduling
Relocate cafeteria/kitchen to existing gym, which will provide adequate space for student seating, appropriate size kitchen serving, and flexibility for large group presentations



3. Existing Gymnasium is inadequate for large Physical Education classes, indoor recess, community use and after school events
Building a new Gymnasium allows the flexibility to address needs for safety/security and an overcrowded cafeteria while addressing needs for elementary event space

Additional Improvements

- Building System upgrades to heating, ventilation, plumbing and electrical
- Selective upgrades to flooring, ceiling, and lighting in hallways
- Site improvements include additional parking and playground area
