School Hours:

Bus Route Form

Please return your bus route form when you register. Even if you do not utilize the bus, we need this form returned. If you are uncertain of the route or the bus number that your child(ren) will be riding, contact Schultz Bus Company at 920-349-8191. If your child is a bus rider, we encourage you to start this with the first day of school. Not only is it good to get your child into a routine, it is easier on the busses to ensure that all children are picked up. If you wanted to come with your child the first day, encourage them to ride the bus and meet them here. This is a simple way that we can work with the bus company to ensure the safety of our children.

Lunch/Milk

We use a computer generated hot lunch recording system. Families receive a four-digit number that applies to ALL children within the family and parents as well. It works like a checking account. Money is deposited into the account and withdrawn as the number is entered. Parents can log on their account via the district website (www.hustisford.k12.wi.us). Family numbers will remain the same as the previous year. New families will receive their numbers after registration is complete. Prices are as follows:

Breakfast \$1.45

Lunch \$2.45

Milk \$.40

Adult Lunch \$3.55

Please be mindful that about half of our students bring cold lunch. Feel free to exercise this option if you prefer. Milk breaks will be allowed for grades 4K-5. Included in this packet is also

a form for the school lunch program, please read it over and contact the office with any questions that you may have regarding free and reduced lunches.

Forms.....

There are several forms included in this packet. The Annual Health Review, Bus Route Form, Emergency Card, and Immunization Form all must be signed and returned to the office. For those of you wishing, please fill out the free/reduced lunch form as well. Watch your child's backpack on the first day of school for additional forms as well. They will be bringing home our school handbook, volunteer form, school calendar, walk, ride, photo forms, insurance forms, and the handbook signature sheet.

Emergency Information

While stated previously, it is imperative that we have emergency contact information in the school office on the FIRST day of school. Injuries and other issues do arise, even on the first day, which require us to contact you. We need to have the most up-to-date information on your child in case of an emergency.

On behalf of everyone at John Hustis Elementary, we welcome you to the start of the school year.
