## Red Cross Babysitting Course

Students who attend our Babysitting Training course, designed and offered by the American Red Cross, will learn how to supervise children and infants, perform basic child-care skills such as diapering and feeding, handle bedtime and discipline issues, identify safety hazards and prevent injuries, as well as caring for common injuries such as choking, burns, cuts and bee stings. They will learn how to communicate effectively with parents and how to find and interviews for babysitting jobs. Students must be at least 11 years of age. This class will be held at Hustisford High School on February 25, 2017 from 9-3. The cost is \$50.00/ student and you will need to bring a lunch.
