**New Business:** 

- Staffing Update—Mrs. Cramer updated on the custodial opening. The committee discussed the retirement of Mrs. Kreitzman and the succession plan for that position. Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on interviews on May 12. Interviews will be conducted for School Counselor and Band.
- OT Agreement—Mrs. Cramer presented the OT agreement with Dodgeland for next year. The contract will remain the same as it was this year. We currently are at 40% and will remain there for next school year.
