Use expected voice level Keep hands and feet to self Follow directions the first time Tell an adult if you feel unsafe Be where you are expected to be Wait your turn Use kind words Show mutual respect Share appreciations Accept and respect differences Participate with a positive attitude Be on time Have expected materials for class Complete homework on time Keep all areas clean and litter free Be helpful	Voice level 1 Respect adults and students Follow directions the first time they are given Use sticks to mark your books Keep the library and lab neat and tidy Raise hand to ask for help Only 3 people in an area of the library at one time	Voice level 0 Walk at all times Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself Walk in a straight line on one side of the hallway, as directed by teacher Stay in line facing forward unless directed by an adult Stop, Look, and Listen when spoken to by adults Put trash in garbage cans Be in classroom by morning announcements (8:10) Keep your hook area picked up and organized	Voice level 0 Walk to and from restroom Report problems in the bathroom to an adult Give people privacy Wait your turn Use and flush toilets appropriately Wash your hands with soap and water Keep water in the sink and off the floor Put trash in garbage cans Use bathroom cards to identify if you may go in Soap = 1 pump Paper towel = 1 piece	Voice level 4 Dress for the weather Walk to and from your class and the playground Hands and feet to self unless in game play Stay in play areas Include everyone Listen to all adults Listen to Safety Patrol Follow the rules of the game Return playground equipment after use Tell an adult if someone is hurt while outside Use bathroom during recess/break time Follow posted playground rules Line up immediately when the bell rings	Voice level 2 Wash hands before entering Wait in line with your hands and feet to yourself Carry lunch tray with two hands Keep all food on your tray Follow directions of adults Sit at assigned table Use table manners Raise your hand if you need help Put all garbage and food on your tray to bring up when dismissed Wait to be dismissed by an adult Try at least one bite of all food on your tray	<u>Everyone:</u> Voice level 2 Nobody in the school hallways before school starts Walk immediately out to the playground, unless eating breakfast Walk at all times Keep hands, feet, and objects to self <u>Pick Up/Walkers:</u> Wait for crossing guard's permission to cross <u>Bus Riders:</u> Follow directions given by bus duty supervisor and Safety Patrol Stay in your own bus line	Voice level 2 before and after assembly Voice level 0 DURING assembly Enter and exit in a straight line Sit appropriately in designated areas Keep hands and feet to self Remain seated unless asked to do otherwise Listen attentively Show mutual respect to the speaker Share in the celebrations and appreciations by clapping Student loses privilege of attending if asked more than once by teachers to make good choices
