# A Message from the Superintendent...

The start of the 2018-2019 school year is just around the corner. Soon the hallways will be busy with students. Staff members have already started to come in to prep for the upcoming school year. This is an exciting time of the year for many. Teachers are prepping their classrooms and preparing new class offerings, the office staff is working to ensure the registration of all students both old and new goes smoothly, and the maintenance crew is prepping classrooms and making the schools shine. Registration is taking place on August 23 and August 28 from 12:00-7:00 pm daily. All families, old and new, are required to come in to register their children for school. The Hustisford Community Fair will be held on August 23 from 4:30-7:00 pm. This is a great time to stop in the high school to see what our fabulous community has to offer. Open house for families and students will be held on Wednesday, August 29 from 4:00-6:00 pm. This is a time for students to bring in their supplies and meet the teachers that they will have. Open house is for both buildings and staff will be available to greet families.

It is for all athletes in grades 7 -12 who may participate on a sports team anytime throughout the year.

While the administrative team has been busy hiring new staff members, we still have several positions that we are working on filling in the district. We are working diligently to ensure that all positions are filled as our students enter into our schools.

Our school has been awarded a WI School Safety Grant. We will be using the funds to place protective covering on doors and update our locks within the buildings. We are also looking at a visitor monitoring system to help ensure the safety and security of our students. The funding is a one-time funding opportunity to help enhance the safety and security of our buildings. Our district was awarded \$41.596.00.

<u>Ms. Bell Reported</u>: Ms. Bell reported on JHE Field Day and all school picnic. She also updated on the end of the year awards assembly. She talked about the reading curriculum training that all elementary teachers participated in on June 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. Summer school is up and running and going very well. The current enrollment counts at JHE for next year is 162 which is down from this year, but kids are registering weekly. Finally, Kid's Club is running for the summer and families have been very gracious that we are providing this service.

C. Athletic Director's Report: Mr. Falkenthal reported that the baseball team had 5 Husty students receive all- conference honors, one softball player, and 6 soccer players. Our girls soccer team ended their season as regional champs.

D. Financial Director's Report: Mr. Kiefer provided information to the board on revenue and expenses so far this year. He showed various accounts and their budget details. He also reported that the district has not had to utilize the line of credit at all this year. He provided some information on various projects that are being considered moving forward. He also provided an update on the end of the year budget status as the fiscal year ends on June 30, 2018.

E. Superintendent's Report: Mrs. Cramer reported that the district submitted a DOJ safety grant and are waiting to hear about it from the Department of Justice. She reported on the policy work being done with NEOLA. She updated on the Watertown Community Health Foundation grant written by Curtis Koch that the district received for an outdoor portable hockey rink. She provided an update on the facility study process as well as the strategic planning process.

- A. History Club—Cheyenne Aason presented information to the board on the start of a History Club for high school students. She indicated that Mr. Jones will be the club advisor. She provided information on the various activities that they would like to see as well as the things that they could offer to the district.
- B. Graduation Date—The board discussed the graduation date for Hustisford High School. Currently the students graduate on a Friday night. With the inclusion of a track and field program next year, if a senior student made it to the state meet; they would potentially miss the graduation ceremony. The board introduced various ideas about a Sunday graduation or maybe a week night. The board will continue to have the discussion. Mrs. Cramer will provide a survey to the staff to gauge their thoughts on graduation.

• Unesco presentation of building study findings—A team from Unesco presented information that they found when surveying teachers and staff about the buildings. They led an ideation session finding out the beliefs of the buildings and grounds team and the focal points that the district has. The session lasted for approximately one hour, allowing for open dialogue between the district team members and the Unesco team. A date will be established to continue the process and move the district forward in regards to facilities.

• Parking Lot Maintenance Bid—Kris Roeseler presented a bid for fixing the parking lot at the HS and for maintenance on the other parking and hard surface. The district is seeking more information from other companies as well in regards to the repair and maintenance that needs to be complete.

• Summer Projects—The committee discussed the various summer projects that are being done including the wall in the SPED room at the HS, gym floor refinishing, various relocation of classrooms, changing of conference room into classroom space, new flooring in library office space at HS.

• School Safety Grant—Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on the school safety grant process. The grant is due on June 8, 2018. The district is eligible for \$20,000 for each school potentially for safety and security upgrades. The main focus of the grant will be to secure classrooms with more effective locks.




