### Key Points from Students – 4K-5

- Upgrade furniture to be more flexible and comfortable
- ► Non fluorescent lighting LED
- Add more windows
- New Smart boards
- Improved heating and cooling
- Cafeteria needs newer tables and a bigger area.
- New floors and reception desk for Library
- ► More flexible furniture in Library
- More technology in Library

- More gym lines with a Falcon on the floor
- Better locker rooms
- Bigger climbing wall, fix net
- Bathrooms need more stalls, new doors, better water and toilets
- Music room stairs can be tough
- New blacktop and basketball hoops outside
- New gaga ball and kickball areas.

## Key Points from Students – Jr. High

- Upgrade furniture to be more flexible and comfortable
- ► Non fluorescent lighting LED
- Better Internet
- New Smart boards
- Improved heating and cooling
- Cafeteria needs newer tables and a bigger area.
- Stage is not really used the wall is closed a lot
- Bathrooms need new paint, more stalls, new sinks and piping.

- New drinking fountains
- Library is not used a lot, it is old, could use new paint and carpet
- Would be nice if Band had more practice rooms
- Auto classes would be nice
- Updated football field scoreboard and add a track.
- More sidewalks
- Update locker rooms with new lockers and benches and more private showers
- Own space for Jr. High

## Key Points from Students – Sr. High

- Library could use updated carpet and no yellow walls.
- Create more of a collaboration space/ large group meeting rooms
- Flexible and more comfortable furniture
- Increased size of all extra-curricular spaces (vo-tech, art)
- Bathrooms and locker rooms need updating
  - Need new partitions
  - Individual shower stalls in locker rooms
- Water quality is not great and not all drinking fountains have cold water – update drinking fountains w/ bottle fillers included.

- Outdoor classroom space
- Functional washer and dryer for athletics
- ► TV's in commons
- New flooring throughout less boring, more color
- Upgraded clocks that all are on the same time.
- Add more windows
- ► Athletic Facilities
  - Practice field for soccer, new hoops and better pavement for outside basketball court, new bleachers

- Modernize & General Updating of both schools (9)
  - Colors
  - ► Flooring at both buildings no orange carpet, replaced worn carpet at JHE
  - ► Wall finishes no carpet on walls
- More Windows at Jr./Sr. High School (2)
- Increased natural light at both schools
- Classroom Updates
- ► New Updated Furniture
- Updated Cafeteria space at both schools
- ► Updated bathrooms at Jr./Sr. High School





#### Identified Areas of Need – Athletic Facilities

- ► Sports Complex Track & Field (3)
- Larger gym at JHE (10)
- ► New High School gym possibly to include a stage for concerts/ dances
- Improve Locker rooms at both facilities
- ► Elementary Playground ground surface & equipment
- Improve Mezzanine space at High school for more multi-sport use



#### Identified Areas of Need – Safety & Security

- \* Based on feedback from last meeting
- Secure entrance at both facilities (15)
- Upgrade Camera System
- Create more welcoming entries (2)
- Sidewalks between the school (2)
- Parking lot updates
  - Blacktop and cement
- ► Larger parking lot for pick-ups at JHE
- Additional shed for vehicle and district storage
- Outdoor Classrooms garden area

#### Identified Areas of Need – Building Systems

- \* Based on feedback from last meeting
- Improved heating and cooling at both schools (19)
- Replace Boilers at both schools
- Air quality
- ▶ New Roof at Jr./Sr. High School (2)
- ► Upgrade Wi-Fi/ internet done in August 2022






## Identified Areas of Need – Learning Environment

- Upgrade Library function and feel at both buildings
- Expand and update Vocational Tech area (11)
- Update Ag space to include Lake Study
- Space for growth
- Collaboration Space/Lounge (2)
- ► Larger Cafeteria both schools (9)
- ► Update commons area at Jr./Sr. High school
- More space for Art at JHE
- Updated science labs and teaching centers (4)
- Updated Stage/ Auditorium (2)
- Increased storage for Activities
- Updated Technology in classrooms



#### **Identified Areas of Need – ADA compliance**

- \* Based on feedback from last meeting
- Update bathrooms at both facilities for ADA compliance (11)
- Access to stage at Jr./Sr. High School

## Identified Areas of Need – Misc.

- Food service to have own delivery vehicle not shared with sports teams
- Improved coming together as a community
- Increased feeling of ownership of the buildings clean up after yourself



### **Facility Assessment Report**




- Building Assessment Highlights:
  - Improved site circulation and traffic flow
  - Two stage entries at both buildings for better security.
  - Replace and add windows to JHE
  - Update Restrooms to meet ADA compliance and improve finishes at both buildings
  - Ceilings, floors and wall finishes have become outdated and worn
  - Roof at Jr./Sr. High school and add gutters to improve drainage
  - Clerestory windows around perimeter show signs where seals are failing and condensation is forming.
  - Enlarge Tech Ed space

## Facility Assessment Report



- Mechanical Assessment Highlights:
  - Replace boilers at both buildings are inefficient and at the end of their lives.
  - Replace aging cooling units and air handlers at both buildings – at the end of their lives.
  - Convert HVAC controls from pneumatic to digital for efficiency and energy savings
  - Replace dust collector at Jr./Sr. High School to for code compliance
- Electrical Assessment Highlights:
  - Update PA and Bells system at both buildings
  - Update clocks to wireless at both buildings
  - Update lighting at both buildings for energy savings and efficiency.
  - Upgrade in classroom technology smartboard, etc.
