April 24: On Site Registration: Registration fee is \$8.00 per student per session plus any additional course materials fee (if applicable). In person registration will take place in the John Hustis Elementary gym from 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM. **NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE 5:00 PM on April 24th**.
