FORMS AND FEES: Please note that EACH student must have 2 completed forms, a general registration form and a course registration form. REGISTRATION AND FEES:

April 16: On Site Registration: Registration fee is \$8.00 per student per session plus any additional course materials fee (if applicable). In person registration will take place in the John Hustis Elementary gym from 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM. **NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE 5:00 PM on April 16th.**

After the April 16th on site registration: Students can bring in forms to either school during regular school hours or forms can be placed in the secure mail box by the front door at the HS, or mail to the Hustisford School District, PO Box 326, Hustisford, WI 53034 in care of Summer School.

Hustisford School District offers a classroom only program that will prepare student drivers for their Behind the Wheel training with any of the private driving schools in our area. Students will learn about driving knowledge and laws, attitudes, emotions, drugs and alcohol, insurance and more. There will be a variety of guest speakers from the insurance industry, law enforcement, trucking industry, organ donation agency and the Dodge County Highway Department. Upon successful completion of the class and age 15 ½, students will be able to sign up for behind the wheel training, then go to the DMV to take their Temporary License (Temps) test.
