#### B. Principals' Reports:

Mr. Bushey Reported: The senior trip was successful, 27 students attended. Three students placed at the Conference Art Show. Shadow day was May 6<sup>th</sup>. Teacher appreciation was May 6-10. The MS staff held a 6<sup>th</sup> grade parent orientation meeting. Scheduling online is going well. Senior Project presentations for current junior students and parents were held. Scholarship night was a great success. Graduation is May 31 at 7pm.

Ms. Bell Reported: Two students from fifth grade were present to present the board with invitations to their graduation ceremony. Summer school registration is underway. There are currently 164 students enrolled. There is a behavior plan that has been implemented for field trips for JHE students. She reported on many upcoming dates at JHE.

Athletic Director's Report: HD Baseball was conference champions! Softball went 2-13 for the season. Track has had a very successful season. HD soccer received a 4 seed for playoffs. They had a nice season.

<u>Financial Director's Report</u>: Mr. Kiefer updated the board on the current 18-19 budget and where it is at. He reviewed this year's open enrollment amounts and there were some variances that affected the overall income for the district. He has the open enrollment period open for Flex Benefits. There are several retirees off of the health plan this summer, he reported that he is working to help ensure a smooth transition. Mr. Kiefer attended a WASBO Conference in Green Bay.

E. Superintendent's Report: Mrs. Cramer reported that the FFA banquet was a success. Senior Project night was a success. Mrs. Cramer met with the Director of the Gathering Source Food Pantry and discussed option for next year for servicing our families. She attended several meetings throughout the month. She was elected to another term on the Trailways Conference Executive Committee. Congrats to Deb and Hank on their retirement. Shatterproof film was applied at the MS /HS on the front entrance.

There is also a need to ensure that the science room at the HS gets thoroughly cleaned. Mrs. Cramer is contacting a company to do a lab audit or safety inspection to ensure that all items within the lab are in working order and safe for use.

#### **New Business:**

- Update from Fred Miller-Director of Technology –Mr. Miller updated the committee on the various projects
  that will be worked on over the summer. He will be completing the server update. He will also be
  completing a telephone software update. IPads for JHE will be ordered and they will be ready over the
  summer. He received information that ERate funding for our internet connection was approved. He
  updated the committee on the test prep that had been done over the past several months. He also
  indicated that he would like to find a student to provide assistance for 2-3 days per week for the summer,
  just as he had last summer.
- Laser Cutter Purchase for Tech. Ed.—Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on the purchase of a laser cutter for teach. Ed. Through the Rural Schools Grant. The committee recommended moving the purchase forward to the May agenda.
- Science Lab Smart Board and Inspection—Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on the need for a Smartboard in the HS Science lab. She also indicated that she will be pursuing an outside lab safety check in order to ensure that all lab equipment is in working order.
- Laptop Cart Computer Replacement Plan—Mr. Miller updated the Committee on the need to update three laptop carts within the district. It is recommended to start with a purchase of 27 computers and continue with a plan moving forward.
- Summer Technology Plan—Mr. Miller provided this information in his technology update.
- Math Update—Mr. Haan talked with Mrs. Cramer about the need to update texts in Pre-Calculus and Calculus. These texts were not updated with the math curricular update. The books were all found used on Amazon. Mrs. Cramer updated that the books were being purchased through the used sites and ranged from \$10-\$25 apiece.

#### **New Business:**

• Budget Update—Mr. Kiefer provided a budget update to the committee.

- Health Insurance Renewal—The renewal rate for health insurance this year through WCA is 9%. The renewal will be placed on the agenda for approval in May.
- Gym Floor Refinishing Bids—Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on the floor refinish bid from Pro Star Surfaces. The item will be on board agenda for May.
- HS Gym Bleacher Bids—Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on the bleacher bid from Pro Star Surfaces. The item will be on board agenda for May.
- JHE Summer Projects—Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on projects for the summer to be completed at JHE. The front, gym, and maintenance door are in need of replacement. There are four classrooms that still need to have the carpeting replaced and tiling done.
- Laser Cutter Purchase for Tech. Ed.—Mrs. Cramer updated the committee on the laser cutter to be purchased out of the rural schools grant. The committee will move the proposal forward for the May board meeting.
- Kids Club –The committee discussed Kid's Club and the resignations. The committee recommended looking for summer assistance with the program and for more permanent help for the school year. There are a couple of individuals that have shown interest in Kid's Club for the summer.
- SRO Position and Funding 2019-2020—Mrs. Cramer provided information to the committee of the cost of the SRO provided by the Village of Hustisford. She is looking into the cost to add days to the position for next school year. The committee asked for some more detailed information about the position and its impact.
- Laptop Replacement Plan for JHE and HS/MS—Mrs. Cramer provided the committee with cost to update three aging laptop carts in the District. Currently it is proposed to replace 27 laptops to begin the replacement/update process.
- Science Lab Smart Board—The HS Science Lab does not have a Smartboard. There is a need for a Smartboard in the
  room. Mrs. Cramer provided information to the committee on a new type of Smartboard/Interactive TV. This information will
  be forwarded on to full board in May.
- 2019-2020 Staff Compensation Increases—Mrs. Cramer asked the committee if there were any questions regarding salary increases for the 19-20 school year that were provided at the April Board meeting. She indicated that she is in the process of updating teacher salaries to identify whether teacher achieved the 10 points needed to advance on the pay scale. She indicated that at the time of the meeting there were about 15 teachers who had earned their points. She is anticipating that number to be higher. Teacher contracts will be prepared for the May board meeting.

The committee recommends to approve the position at the May board meeting.
