With the failed referendum and no access to the Trust Fund Loan, plans are being vetted to establish a tuition agreement with Dodgeland, pending Board approval for our students to receive educational services for the 2026-27 school year. 2. Review draft tuition agreement: Work is underway to vet and establish a tuition agreement with Dodgeland for the 2026-27 school year. The tuition agreement would allow students to attend Dodgeland for their educational services. Transportation would be provided to all students who participate.
 - a. Recommendation to review the tuition agreement and consider approval at the next Board meeting.

3. Resolution to provide transportation to Open Enrollment (OE) students: As the end of the open enrollment application window approaches, April 30, 2026 at 4:00 PM, we are working with area Superintendents to provide transportation to Hustisford students that open enroll into their district (nonresident district). This resolution gives permission to the area districts to cross Hustisford boundaries to pick up OE students, at designated pick-up/drop-off locations. This resolution does not require any district to participate in this arrangement, it simply provides permission to area districts to cross into our boundaries to pick up OE students, IF the nonresident school board approves such an arrangement through their own resolution. This option may provide some relief for parents struggling to provide transportation for open enrollment.
 - a. Recommendation to review the transportation resolution to allow area school districts to enter the boundaries of the Hustisford School District to pick-up/drop-off OE students, and consider approval at the next meeting.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT WITH THE DODGELAND,
MAYVILLE, HORICON, WATERTOWN, HARTFORD UNION HIGH SCHOOL, HARTFORD
JOINT 1 AND THE HERMAN-NEOSHO-RUBICON SCHOOL DISTRICTS, FOR OPEN
ENROLLED STUDENTS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes § 121.54(10), a school district may elect, but is not required, to provide transportation for pupils attending school under open enrollment, including transportation to and from summer classes; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes § 121.54(10) further provides that a nonresident school district may not transport a pupil to or from a location within the boundaries of the pupil's resident school district without the approval of the resident school district; and

WHEREAS, the School Districts of DODGELAND, MAYVILLE, HORICON, WATERTOWN, HARTFORD UNION HIGH SCHOOL, HARTFORD JOINT 1 AND HERMAN-NEOSHO-RUBICON serves as a nonresident school district for certain students who reside within the boundaries of the Hustisford School District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the School Districts of DODGELAND, MAYVILLE, HORICON, WATERTOWN, HARTFORD UNION HIGH SCHOOL, HARTFORD JOINT 1 AND THE HERMAN-NEOSHO-RUBICON desires to provide transportation services to such open enrolled students in a manner that is efficient and consistent with state law; and

WHEREAS, such transportation may require entry into the geographic boundaries of the Hustisford School District for the purpose of student pickup and drop-off; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin law permits such transportation only upon approval of the resident school district and through mutual agreement between districts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the School District of Hustisford authorizes the provision of transportation services for open enrolled students residing within the Hustisford School District, in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes § 121.54(10), for the period beginning **June 8, 2026, through June 30, 2027**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Districts of DODGELAND, MAYVILLE, HORICON, WATERTOWN, HARTFORD UNION HIGH SCHOOL, HARTFORD JOINT 1 AND THE HERMAN-NEOSHO-RUBICON may enter into the geographic boundaries of the Hustisford School District for the purpose of transporting such students during this period, contingent upon the approval of the Hustisford School District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes the Superintendent and/or designee to negotiate and execute a written agreement with the DODGELAND, MAYVILLE, HORICON,

WATERTOWN, HARTFORD UNION HIGH SCHOOL, HARTFORD JOINT 1 AND THE HERMAN-NEOSHO-RUBICON School Districts to permit such transportation, including pickup and drop-off locations within Hustisford School District boundaries, for the same period; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any such agreement shall comply with all applicable state statutes and district policies; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Superintendent shall keep the Board informed regarding the status and implementation of any such agreement.
